

#### It's in the Constitution!

The United States Census (plural censuses or censi) is a decennial census mandated by Article I, Section 2 of the United States Constitution, which states: "Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States... according to their respective Numbers... The actual Enumeration shall be made within three years after the first meeting of the Congress of the United States, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years". ~ Wikipedia



# Confidentiality

Census staff take a lifelong oath

Violations come with a fine of \$250,000 and/or up to 5 years in jail

#### FINE PRINT:

Federal Law Protects Your Information. The U.S. Census Bureau is bound by <u>Title 13</u> of the United States Code. This laws not only provides authority for the work we do, but also provides strong protection for the information we collect from individuals and businesses. As a result, the Census Bureau has one of the strongest confidentiality guarantees in the federal government. It is against the law for any Census Bureau employee to disclose or publish any census or survey information that identifies an individual or business. This is true even for inter-agency communication: the FBI and other government entities do not have the legal right to access this information. In fact, when these protections have been challenged, Title 13's confidentiality guarantee has been upheld.



When it's time to respond, most households will receive an invitation in the mail. Every household will have the option of responding online, by phone, or by mail.


Every household that hasn't responded will receive reminders and will eventually receive a paper questionnaire.
















### **Next Steps**
