The Commission listened to the presentation, made comments, and questioned Peter Jensen (Magical Bridge Foundation) regarding the schematic design, layout, features, benefits and components of the Magical Bridge All Inclusive Playground that is planned and approved for Central Park. The Commission expressed interest in including a water feature in the playground.

Bowers Park Rehabilitation Project was submitted for the Award of Excellence at the California Parks & Recreation Society (CPRS) Banquet which will be held at the Mountain View Community Center at 6:00 PM on Thursday, February 27, 2020. The Homeridge Park Rehabilitation Project will go to Council for award of bid in two weeks.

Chair Knaack: Visited Fremont Park and Alvarez Park. Attended the Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremony, and thought it was great how much could actually fit inside the Community Recreation Center for the event.

Commissioner Walke: Visited Reed & Grant Sports Park and noticed the playground installation is finished. Attended the Holiday Tree Lighting Ceremony and felt that it felt nice and low key. Visited Montague Park and mentioned that it would be nice when the rehabilitation project begins at that park.
