I want to voice my objection to Ordinance 2015.

The issues with this ordinance are that it extends the "Eviction Moratorium " for 6 months, without regard to the rights of landlords, terms of contracts between tenant and property owners, actual requirement for proof of need, and without right of appeal or exemption from the ordinance for undue hardship.
