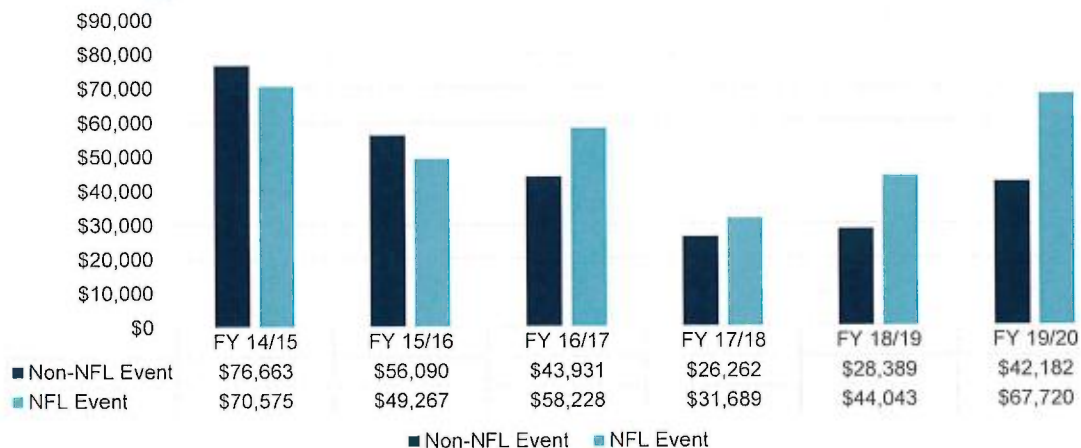

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Recommendation

Approve Amendment No. 4 to the Agreement with the California Highway Patrol in the amount of \$2,500,000, for a total not to exceed amount of \$8,424,811, and extending the term of the agreement to June 30, 2022, for traffic management and support services for special events at Levi's Stadium.
