# **City Council Concerns**

- April 7, 2020 Report to Council to Consider Service
   Agreement with Alta Planning + Design
- City Council deferred approval due to shelter in place constraints
- Concerns with low traffic volume data and inability to hold public meetings

### **Data Collection**

- Traffic volumes significantly decreased since March 2020
- 22 intersection traffic counts needed for project
- Traffic data will be obtained by:
  - Using recent historical data for 10 intersections
  - Collect 2021 data for 22 intersections
  - Adjust data by developing engineering adjustment factors at 12 locations without historical count data

#### **Outreach**

- Original scope of work included multiple in-person stakeholder and community meetings.
- Outreach modified with new strategies such as:
  - Up to 15 total events using internet teleconferencing platform with stakeholder groups, social media (i.e. Youtube, Facebook Live), City boards, community workshops
  - Postcard mailings
  - Project website, phone number hotline, and online survey
  - Sidewalk decals
