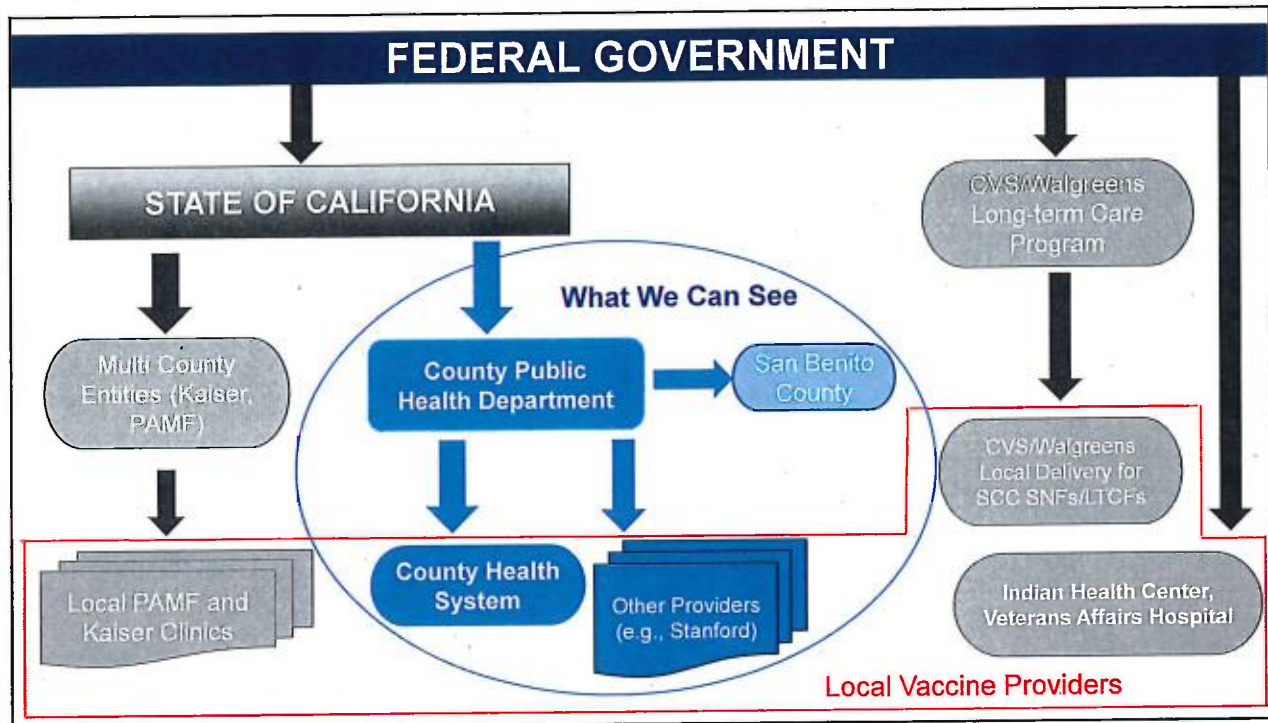

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Healthcare workers</li> <li>Long-term care residents</li> </ul> <p>See CDPH Allocation Guidelines for Phase 1A.</p>	<p><b>1B Tier One:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Individuals 75 and older</li> <li>Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors: education, childcare, emergency services, and food and agriculture</li> </ul> <p><b>1B Tier Two:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Individuals 65-74 years of age</li> <li>Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors: transportation and logistics; industrial, commercial, residential and sheltering facilities and services, critical manufacturing</li> <li>Congregate settings with outbreak risk: incarcerated and homeless</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Individuals 50-64 years of age</li> <li>People 16-49 years of age and have an underlying health condition or disability which increases their risk of severe COVID-19</li> <li>Those at risk of exposure at work in the following sectors: water and wastewater; defense; energy; chemical and hazardous materials; communications and IT; financial services; government operations / community-based essential functions</li> </ul>
