

Open indoors at 20% capacity:

Personal care services

(e.g. hair salons and barber shops;
nail care; body art, tattoo, and
piercing shops; esthetician, skin care,
and cosmetology services;
electrology, waxing, threading, and
other hair removal services)

Still in effect:



- > Mandatory Directive on Travel (requires most people who travel into the county from more than 150 miles away to quarantine for 10 days upon their arrival)
- Mandatory Directive for Lodging Facilities

 (Lodging facilities may not provide lodging services for non-essential purposes, such as tourism, recreational, or leisure purposes)
