Messaging related to surrounding neighborhoods

- Information included in January 27th, 2021 email updates to all students:
 - Sanctions for Student Behavior

Students who are found to be responsible for hosting events on or off campus, participating in social gatherings in violation of the <u>county order</u> (*Gatherings that include more than 3 households are prohibited*— *this includes everyone present, including hosts and guests*), or failing to abide by recommended isolation and quarantine recommendations are subject to a fine of \$500 and suspension from the University. A student on suspension is not eligible to be enrolled at the University for a specified period of time.

To address egregious behaviors in a timely manner, students who violate the Conduct Code will be subject to an expedited conduct hearing process administered by the Office of Student Life.



Santa Clara University Pandemic Response

Remote learning and closed campus since mid-March 2020

Resilience & Recovery program launched by President to manage through COVID-19 pandemic

R&R operations team tasked with providing support guidelines and support necessary to keep the campus community safe



Focus: Prevent and Protect

Prevent

- Closed campus
- Remote work for majority of faculty/staff
- On-campus housing reduced to ~200 in need of emergency housing
- Daily Symptom Tracker for essential faculty/staff coming to campus
- Masks required
- Air filters upgraded
- Waste water testing program

Protect

- Free testing for faculty, staff, students, contractors
- Tracing program
- Isolation / Quarantine space and support








4. QUARANTINE

Testing

- * Free to faculty, staff, students, contractors
- * Weekly three sites, three days per week

Tracing

- Group of 26 staff redeployed as tracers for the SCU community and fully trained in the State tracing program as CICTs (Case Investigators/Contact Tracers)
- Direct integration with CalCONNECT
- Traced over 300 positive cases which includes:
 - Multiple calls, emails, texts to reach positive case
 - Offer information and resources for isolation
 - Over 99% of SCU cases have been contacted
- X5100 phone line for all community members to report positive COVID result (for those tested outside of SCU program)



Isolation & Quarantine

- Comprehensive plan for supporting students with shelter, food, physical/mental wellness checks for isolation period after testing positive
- Comprehensive plan for supporting students with food for quarantine after being identified as a close contact of a positive COVID positive individual
- Housing building complex held offline for 2020-21 for isolation cases



Winter Quarter (Jan-Mar)

- 68 grad/law
- 196 undergraduate
- Extremely limited in-person instruction
- Grab and go food service
- Cowell Health by appt or telehealth
- NO Neighborhood Units

Spring Quarter (Apr-June)

- Possible increase of on-campus housing for undergraduates
- Continued limited in-person instruction
- Depending on county or state guidance, slow re-opening of library, Benson Memorial Center, outdoor recreation
- NO Neighborhood Units
