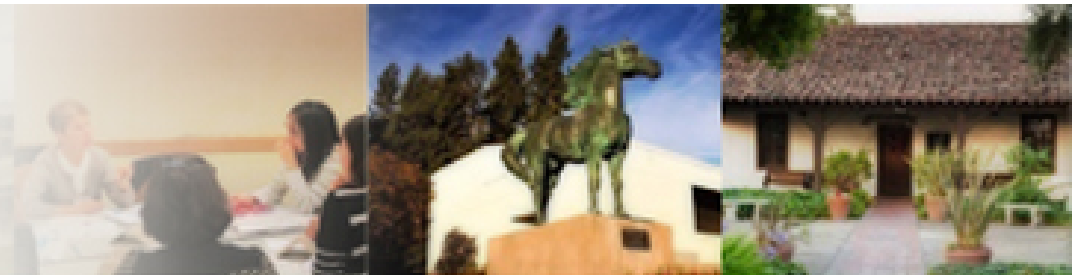

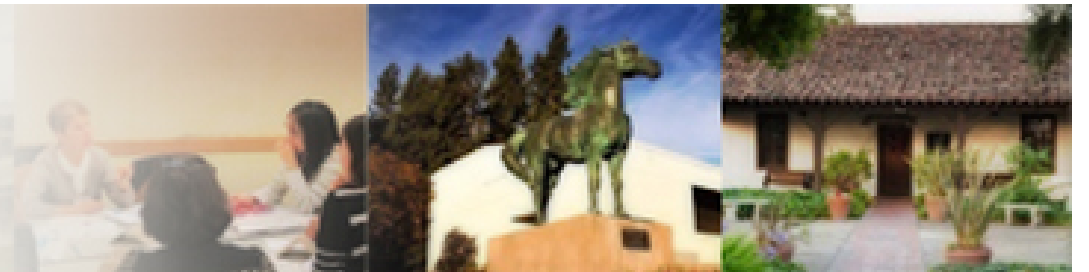
Potential Insurance Companies

- General Liability Insurance

- Coverage amounts:

- Commercial General Liability (CGL), with policy limits not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence covering bodily injury and property damage;
 - CGL Primary Insurance Endorsement; and
 - This CGL policy shall include an endorsement which adds the City of Santa Clara, its Council, employees, and officers as additional insureds.
 - Business Automotive Liability (BAL), with policy limits not less than \$1,000,000
 - Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability with policy limits of California statutory limits.

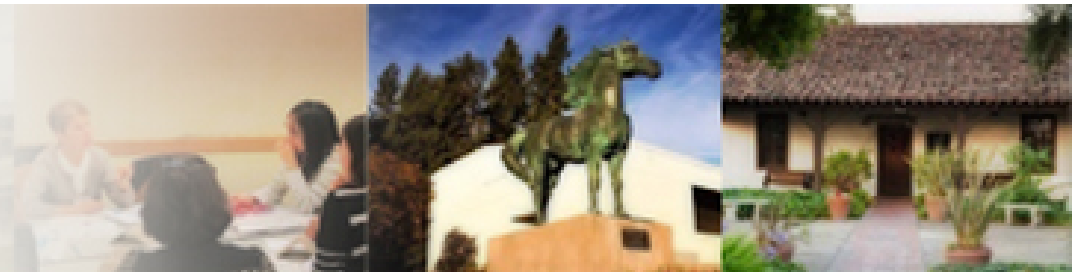

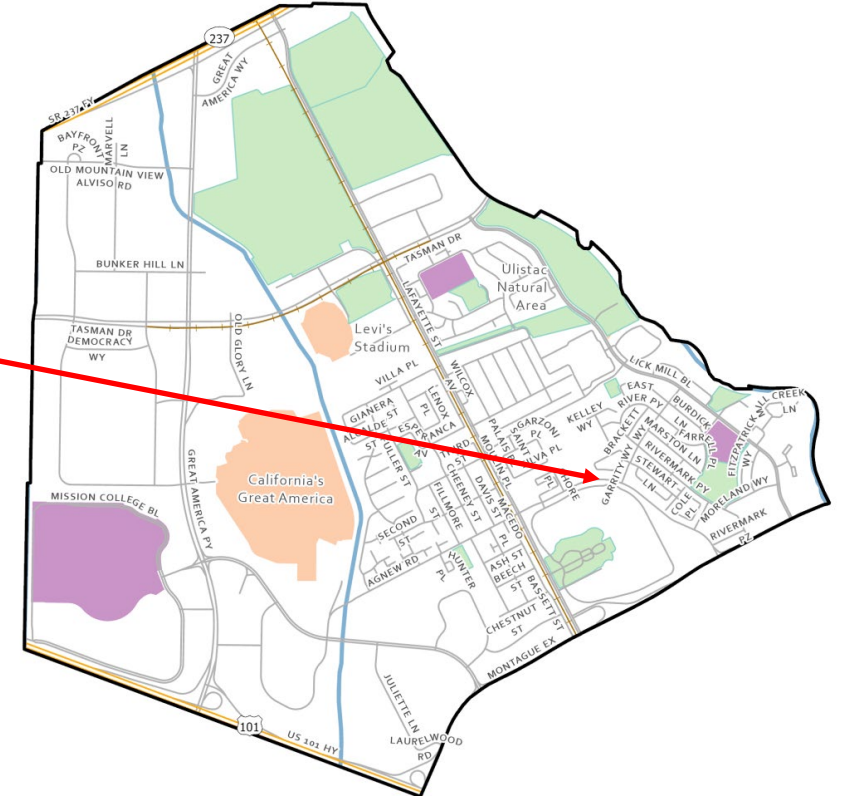

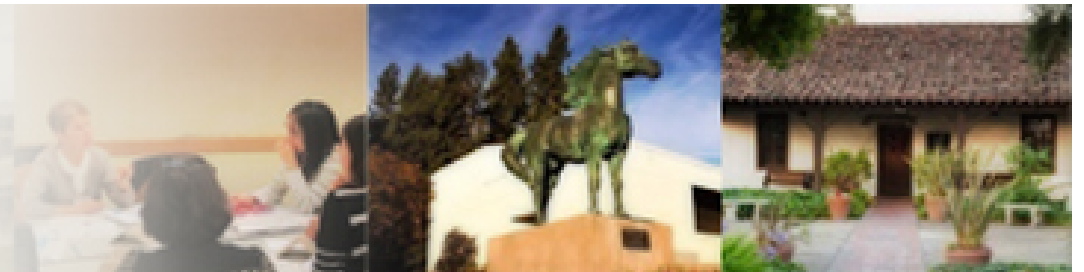


Proposed Location

 - Agnew/Harrigan

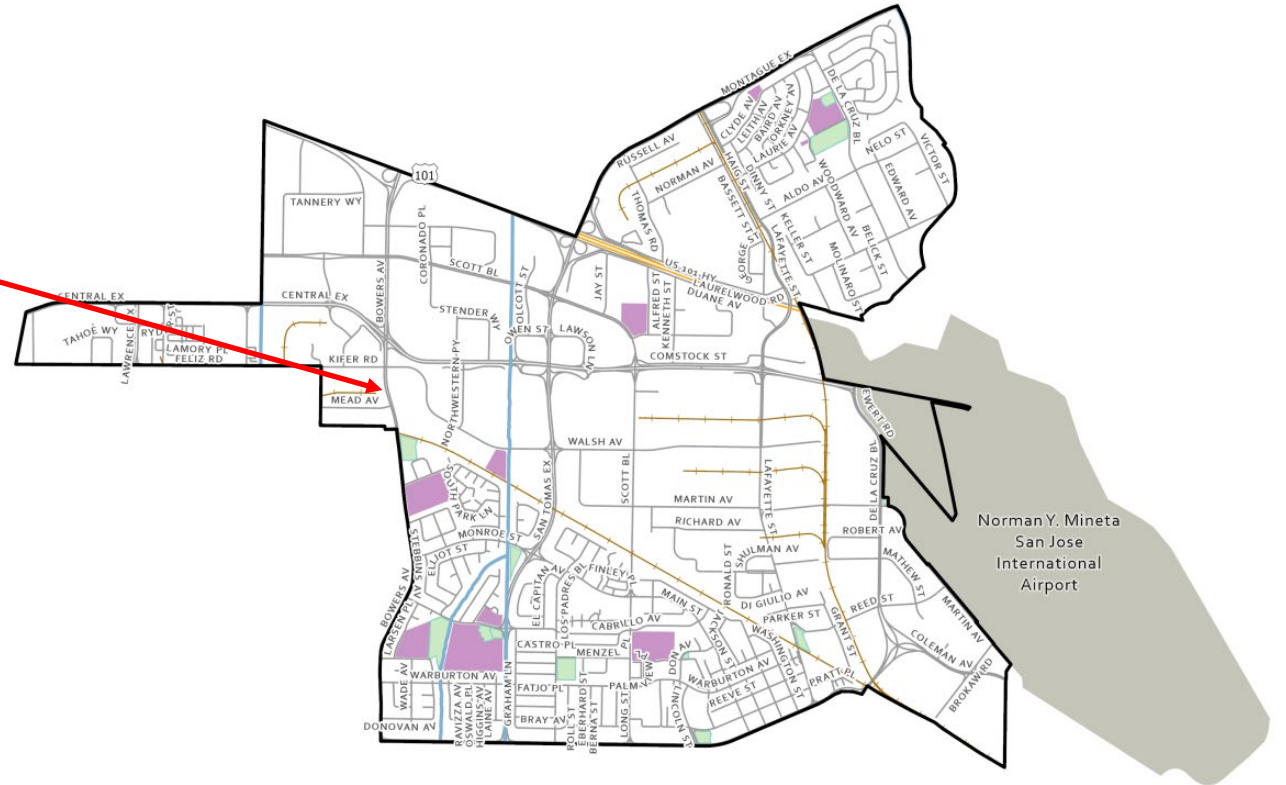
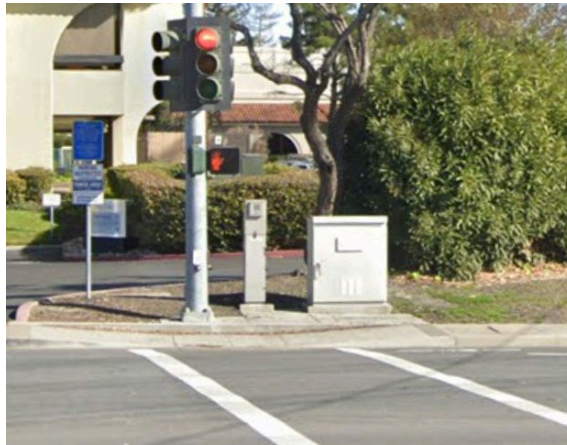

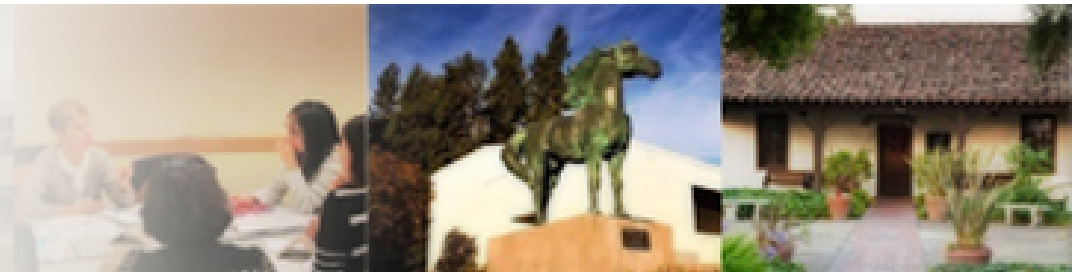


Proposed Location

 - In front of Keypoint CU

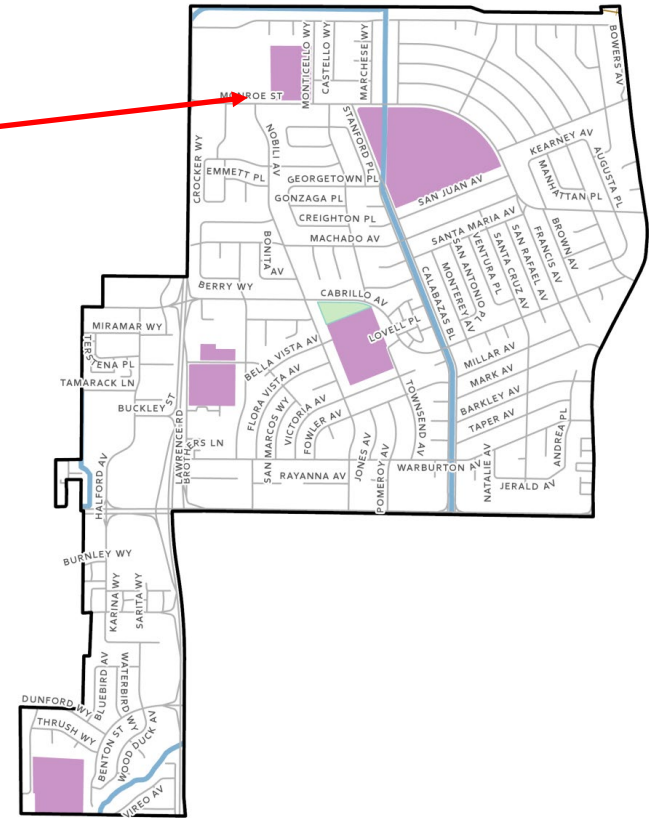

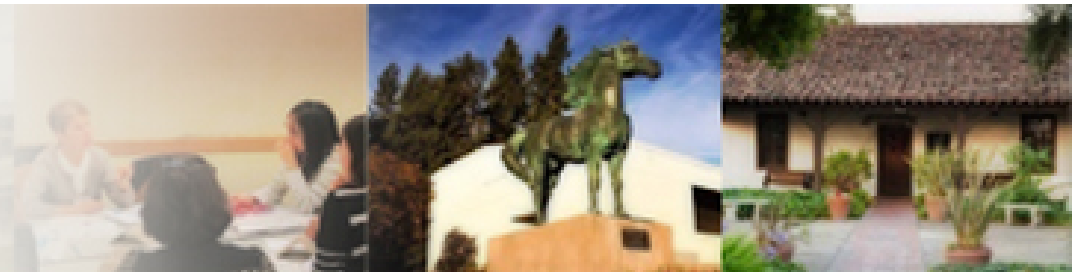


Proposed Location

 - Monroe/Nobili Ave

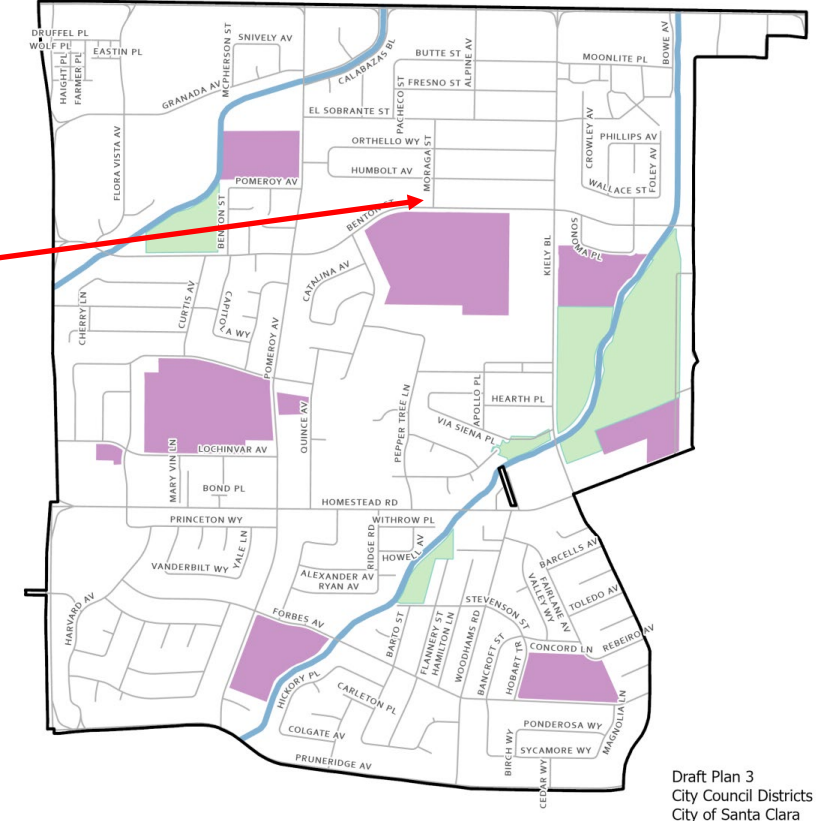

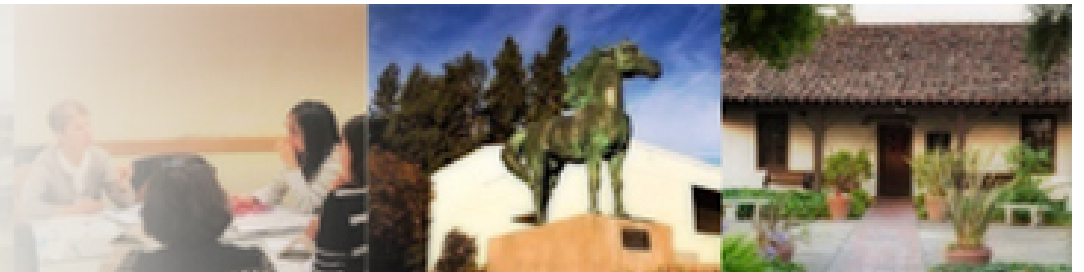
Proposed Location

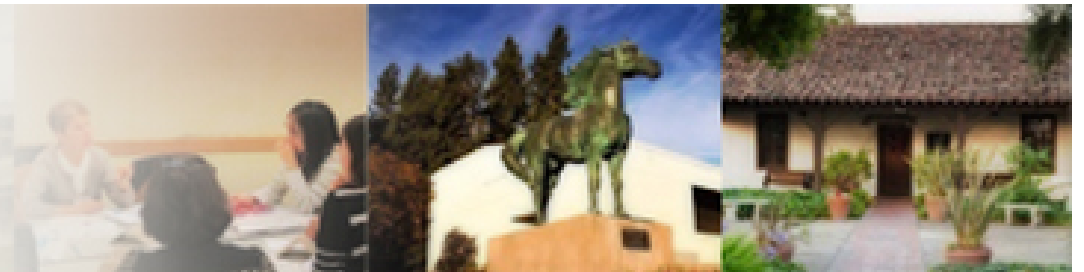


Proposed Location

 - In front of Chick-fil-A

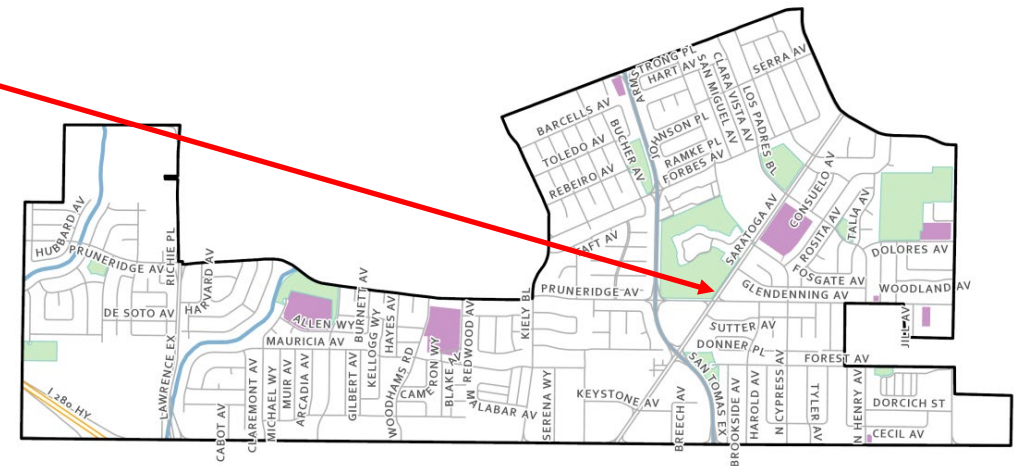

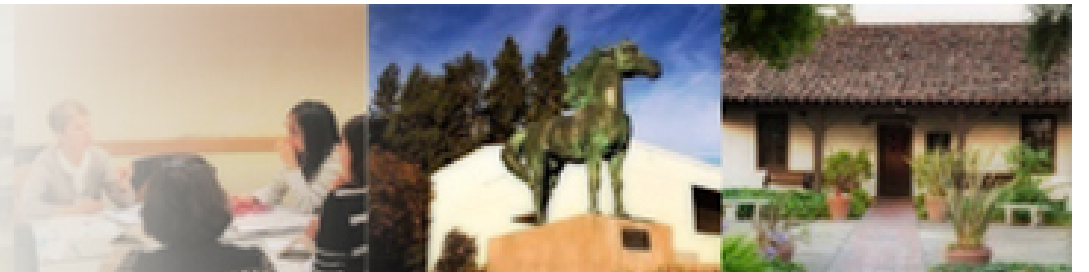


Proposed Location

 - In front of 7-11



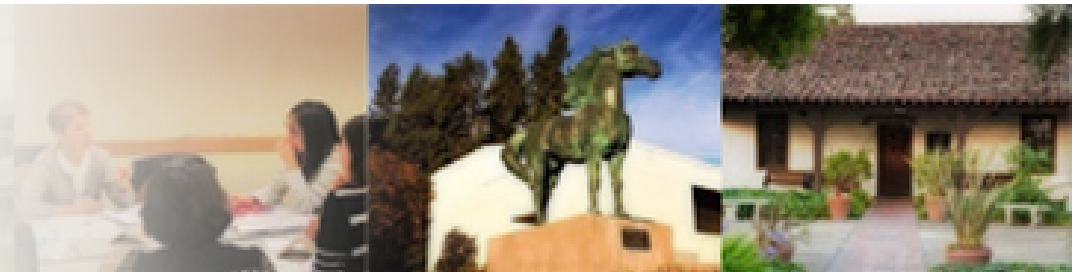

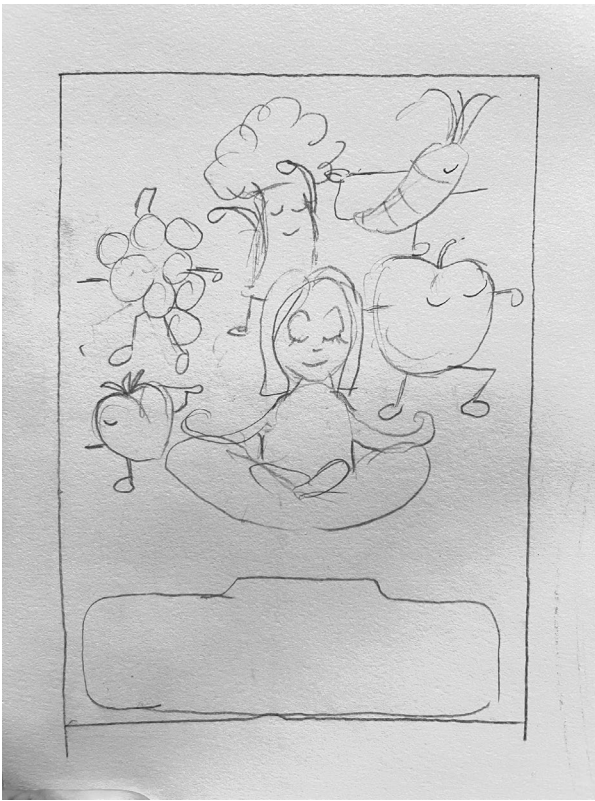


Program Notes

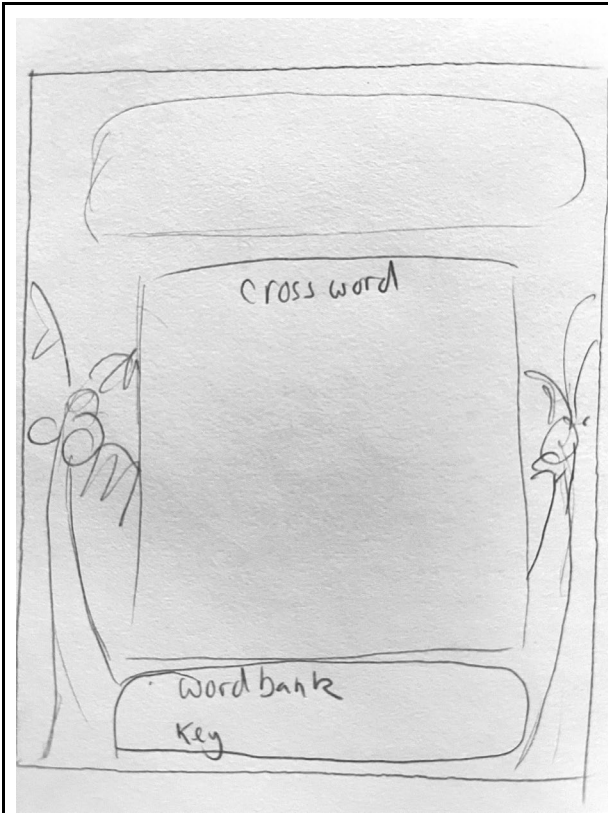

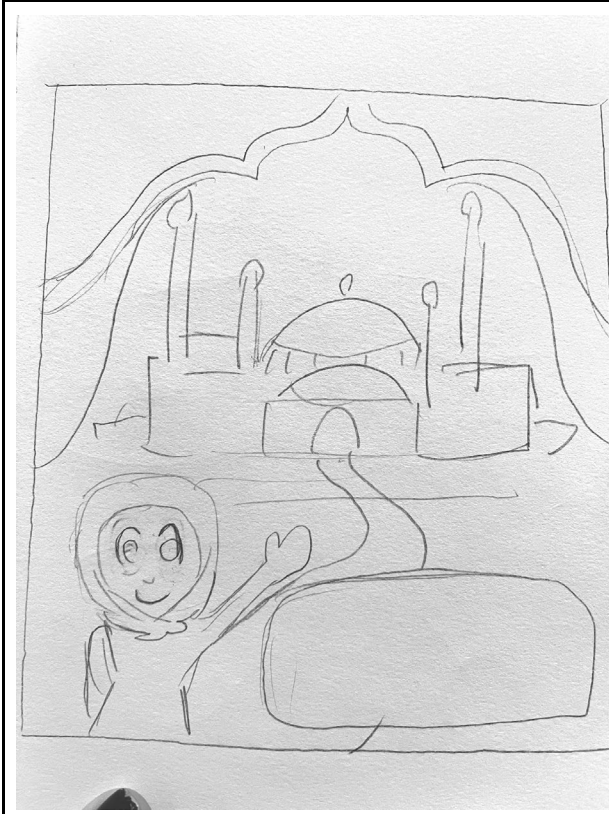

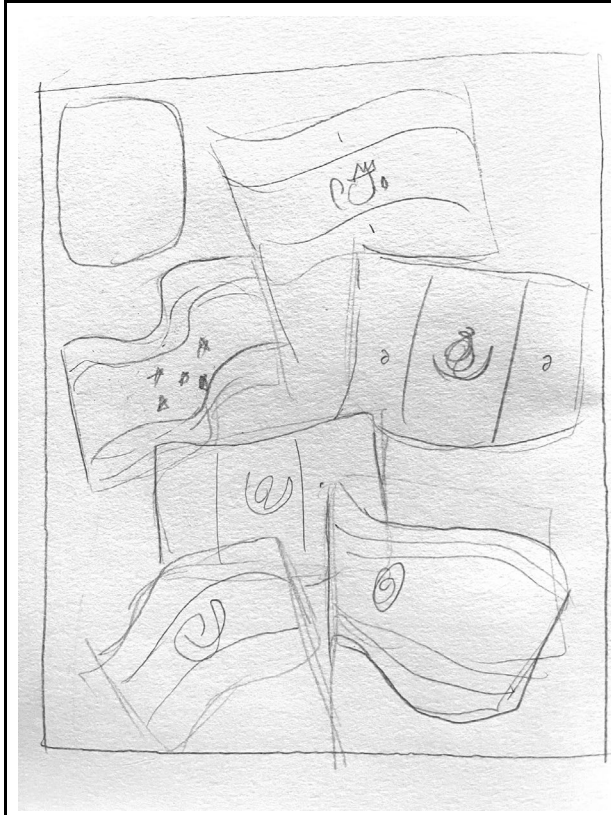

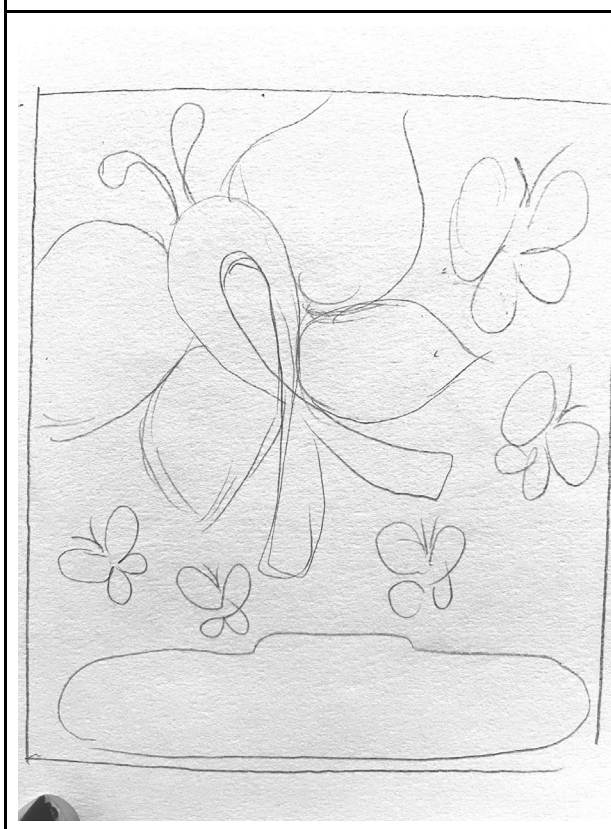
