Breathe California Youth Vaping and Tobacco Presentation

**BACKGROUND**

As the local clean air and healthy lungs leader, Breathe California of the Bay Area, Golden Gate, and Central Coast fights lung disease in all its forms and works with its communities to promote lung health. Breathe California provides education to youth and other community members to promote lung health in all forms. Breathe California increased its vaping presentations and workshops to youth in the Bay Area in 2018, in response to the escalation in youth vaping and flavored tobacco use.
