**SUBJECT**

Youth Commission Committee Report on Work Plan Goal-Inclusiveness

**BACKGROUND**

The Youth Commission FY 2019/20 Work Plan includes a goal to foster inclusiveness amongst their peers and within the community. During the past two terms, commissioners have hosted the Inclusive Makerspace, a STEM-based event for youth with special needs. This term, they are looking to focus on highlighting the variety of cultures present in the San Francisco Bay Area, specifically those within the City of Santa Clara.

**DISCUSSION**

The Youth Commission’s Inclusiveness Committee (Committee) members will provide an update to meeting attendees on ideas to implement the Committee’s goals. One of the possible activities is to host a Multicultural Fair where the public can learn more about the cultures in the Bay Area. Cultural groups would be invited to share a performance, provide information about their culture, and highlight their unique foods through food vendors. Committee members are expected to discuss and gather feedback on their tentative activity.
