REPORT TO COUNCIL

SUBJECT

Action on a Resolution Amending in Part Resolution 5195, Approving the 2019 Cultural Commission Calendar of Meetings, and Setting the Number and Start Time of the Regular Meetings of the Cultural Commission

BACKGROUND

The City Code states that each board or commission shall hold regular meetings at the times and on the days indicated by resolution of the City Council. Resolution 5195 (Attachment 1), which was adopted by the City Council in 1987, states that the Cultural Advisory Commission shall hold meetings on the first Monday of each month at 7:30 p.m. except when such day falls on a City holiday.

DISCUSSION

At the February 4, 2019 Cultural Commission meeting, the Commission recommended the proposed 2019 Schedule of Meetings (Attachment 2), which includes 11 meetings on the first Monday of each month, except for September due to the Labor Day Holiday, and recommended a modified start time of 7:00 p.m., beginning in March 2019. A proposed resolution, which would amend the previously adopted Resolution 5195 in regards to the Cultural Commission scheduling of regular meetings is attached to this report (Attachment 3) for Council consideration.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The action being considered does not constitute a "project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(5) in that it is a government organizational or administrative activity that will not result in direct or indirect changes in the environment.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact other than administrative time and expense to set the meetings.
