### **SUBJECT**

Youth Commission 2018-19 Work Plan & Goals Update

### **BACKGROUND**

The Youth Commission develops an annual work plan for each term which is created through a discussion of current trends relating to the youth and teen population. For the 2017-18 term the following goals were selected based on priority and community needs: foster inclusiveness in the community, increase intergenerational awareness and opportunities, and increase youth understanding and participation in local government.

### **DISCUSSION**

Youth Commissioners will begin discussing trends and ideas to consider for the 2018-19 term work plan. The discussion will continue through the October 9, 2018 Youth Commission's joint meeting with Mayor and City Council.
