Youth Commission Committee Report on Work Plan Goal-Inclusive Makerspace

BACKGROUND

Youth Commission FY2018-19 Work Plan includes a goal to host an Inclusive Makerspace. The purpose of an Inclusive Makerspace will be to provide persons with special needs to explore STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) activities. An Inclusive Makerspace was initially held during the 2017-18 term at the Central Library in collaboration with the Library, the Parks & Recreation Therapeutic Recreation Services Program, and the Youth Commission. Over 200 youth with special needs and their families attended the event.

DISCUSSION

Committee members will provide an update to meeting attendees on the event plans and logistics such as date and location, number and type of activities, event schedule, member participation and support, and marketing.
