## REPORT TO COUNCIL

### SUBJECT

Action on a Resolution Approving the 2019 Salary Setting Commission Calendar of Meetings, and Setting the Number and Start Time of Regular Meetings of the Salary Setting Commission

### BACKGROUND

City Charter Section 1003 states that each of the boards and commissions of the City shall hold regular meetings as required by City Code. City Code Section 2.120.030 states that each board or commission shall hold regular meetings at the times and on the days indicated by resolution of the City Council, which resolutions may be amended from time to time by further resolution of the Council.

### DISCUSSION

At the January 8, 2019 Salary Setting Commission meeting, the Commission recommended the proposed 2019 Schedule of Meetings (Attachment 1). In addition to recommending the 2019 Schedule of Meetings, the Salary Setting Commission's action also recommended a start time for regular meetings to begin at 7:00 p.m.

A proposed resolution setting the Salary Setting Commission scheduling of regular meeting dates and start time is attached to this report (Attachment 2).

### ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW
