REPORT TO COUNCIL

SUBJECT

Action on Appointment to fill a partial term on the Planning Commission ending June 30, 2019 and approve the newly appointed commissioner to serve a full term from July 1, 2019 ending June 30, 2023

BACKGROUND

At the April 1, 2019 Special City Council meeting, Council held interviews to fill a vacancy on the Planning Commission. At that meeting, fifteen applicants were interviewed, and Council established an eligibility list effective for one-year to fill future vacancies. Those placed on the eligibility list were the top three vote getters: Jayapriya Cherukuru, Megan Swartzwelder and Vandana Upadhyay. At the May 7, 2019 Council meeting, Council declared a vacancy on the Planning Commission and approved to interview from the eligibility list.

DISCUSSION

All three applicants on the eligibility list have confirmed their interest to proceed to the interviews.

1. Jayapriya Cherukuru
2. Megan Swartzwelder
3. Vandana Upadhyay

Attached are the Applications (Attachment 1) and Voting Guidelines (Attachment 2) for the appointment to Boards and Commissions which outlines the process for conducting interviews and casting votes by Council.
