## REPORT TO PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION

#### **SUBJECT**

39th Annual Art & Wine Festival - Event Evaluation

#### **BACKGROUND**

The 39<sup>th</sup> Annual Santa Clara Art & Wine Festival was scheduled for September 14 and 15, 2019 in Central Park. Hosting the festival is one of the Commission Work Plan Goals for FY2019-20. The Parks & Recreation Commission reviews and makes recommendations on aspects of the festival including: entertainment; beer, wine, token, and commemorative glass selection, quantities, pricing and service locations; Commissioner assignments; charitable organization volunteer assignments and fund distribution; and event promotion.

### **DISCUSSION**

The Parks & Recreation Commission will discuss and evaluate the 39<sup>th</sup> Annual Santa Clara Art & Wine Festival and provide recommendations to improve the festival in the coming year. Discussion and consideration of distribution of financial grants from net glass and token booth revenues to charitable organizations will be scheduled for a future Commission meeting.
