REPORT TO COUNCIL

SUBJECT

Action on Bills and Claims Report (CC, SA) for the period January 31st, 2020 - February 20th, 2020 [Council Pillar: Enhance Community Engagement and Transparency] Continued from March 17, 2020

BACKGROUND

Disbursements made by the City are based on invoices submitted for payment. Prior to payment, staff reviews all disbursement documents to ensure they are reflective of the goods or services provided. Invoices are usually paid within 30 days of receipt of an accurate invoice. As the final step, the City Auditor, or her designee verifies all documents before payment is issued. Payments are issued through accounts payable checks and wire transfers. It's important to note that items that pertain to the Stadium Authority are billed to the Stadium Manager (ManCo) to pay on behalf of the Stadium Authority for Non-NFL events and the 49ers for NFL events.

The Bills and Claims Report represents the cash disbursements required for operations of the City during the period. The report reflects the payment date, invoice number, description of the payment, funding source, and payment amount for all invoices. The budget control is set by the City Council through the budget adoption process.

DISCUSSION

Significant expenditures in this time period include:

- Payment to City of San Jose in the amount of \$27,278,463 for FY2019-20 San Jose-Santa Clara Regional Wastewater Facility (RWF) third quarter capital, operation maintenance billing and installment of the revolving fund loan.
- Payment to Northern California Power Agency in the amount of \$13,747,903 for February 2020 all resources bill and Western Restoration fund.

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- Payment to MSR Public Power Agency in the amount of \$3,390,451 for January and February 2020 energy purchase.
- Payment to Tri-Dam Authority/project in the amount of \$2,280,019 for January 2020 Hydroelectric purchase.
- Payment to Ethosenergy in the amount of \$2,112,755 for materials used and services performed through January 12, 2020 on Mitsubishi Steam Turbine Overhaul project.
- Payment to Santa Clara Valley Water District in the amount of \$1,353,940 for November 2019
 Pump tax, a groundwater charge that is used to pay for the protection and augmentation of
 water supplies in the basin.

Payments to ManCo are not included in the City's Bills and Claims report as they are currently reported through a separate Stadium Authority Bills and Claims report. Stadium Authority related payments in the City's Bills and Claims report include general administrative, materials, and supplies expenses of approximately \$122,900. Included in this amount are expenses to Santa Clara County Sheriff's Department, City of Sunnyvale for special law enforcement services at stadium events, and Law Enforcement Psychological for psychological assessment of Special Event Officers. These expenses are reimbursed to the City by the Stadium Authority.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

The action being considered does not constitute a "project" within the meaning of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15378(b)(4) in that it is a fiscal activity that does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potential significant impact on the environment.

FISCAL IMPACT

The expenditures of \$65,277,369 were appropriated to various funds with the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2019/20 Budget, as amended.

PUBLIC CONTACT
