Discussion of Potential Interview Topics for City Librarian Recruitment

### COUNCIL PILLAR

#### BACKGROUND

During the March 1, 2021 meeting of the Board of Library Trustees, Acting City Librarian Cynthia Bojorquez gave an update on the recruitment process of the new City Librarian.
