# **BACKGROUND**

The Youth Commission develops an annual work plan for each term which is created through a discussion of current trends relating to the youth and teen population. In recent terms, Commissioners have chosen a variety of goals including:

- encourage health and wellness,
- public outreach, environmentalism outreach and education, and
- foster inclusiveness in the community.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Youth Commissioners have prioritized their top priorities to consider for the FY2021/22 term work plan. Commissioners are expected to finalize their work plan and goals at the November 9, 2021 meeting, including but not limited to:

- Community Building: Multi-cultural activity;
